What do I need?

There are no formal entry requirements for this course; however you do need to be aged 19 or over, be unemployed or on benefits. You also need to have been a resident in the UK/EU for 3 years prior to starting the course.

Programme Structure

The programme is made up of the following components:

- Level 1 Certificate in Construction Skills (Construction Operations)
- Level 1 Award in Health & Safety in a Construction Environment Qualification

Training Covers

- Introduction to health and safety in construction
- Introduction to construction in industry
- Laying block paving
- Laying paving using slabs
- Mixing and using concrete
- Level 1 Award in Health & Safety in a Construction Environment qualification required for CSCS Card
- Asbestos Awareness
- Environmental Awareness and CSCS touch screen test and CSCS Card - when all course elements

Foundation Skills:

You will also acquire foundation skills required (Including updating your CV) to seek employment and/or career progression in the construction sector including roles as a labourer

Duration and Times

The elements of the course are delivered over 2 to 3 weeks. 9:00am to 4:00pm each day.
