





### What do I need?

There are no formal entry requirements for this course; however you do need to be aged 19 or over, be unemployed or on benefits. You also need to have been a resident in the UK/EU for 3 years prior to starting the course.

The programme is made up of the following components:

- Level 1 Certificate in Construction Skills
- Level 1 Award in Health & Safety in a Construction Environment Qualification
- Introduction to Health and Safety in Construction
- Introduction to the Construction Industry
- Painting Techniques
- Tiling a Plain Wall
- Setting Out and Laying Gravel Paths
- Constructing Half-brick Return Corners
- Laying Block Paving
- Mixing and Using Concrete

## **Foundation Skills:**

You will also acquire foundation skills required (Including updating your CV) to seek employment and/or career progression in the construction sector including roles as a labourer.

### **Duration and Times**

The elements of the course are delivered over 2 weeks, 9:00am to 4:30pm each day. Plus one day on course completion for the CSCS element of the course.
